Community grants terms and conditions

- 1. The Pace Farm Community Grants program provides quarterly grants to eligible groups or organisations.
- 2. Eligible initiatives include charitable organisations, local sports teams, community groups, and schools.
- 3. Charitable organisations must be registered with ACNC and provide proof of DGR status if applicable.
- 4. Local sports teams must be registered with a recognised governing body.
- 5. Community groups must be incorporated and provide a clear project plan.
- 6. Schools must provide a letter of endorsement from the school principal or governing authority.
- 7. All applicants must operate within Australia.
- 8. Applicants must submit a detailed project budget and timeline.
- 9. Applications must focus on inclusivity and community betterment.
- 10. Grants can request up to \$5,000 per quarter and division.
- 11. Funding will not be provided to for-profit organisations, political campaigns, or individuals.
- 12. Religious activities are excluded unless non-denominational and community-focused.
- 13. Applications must be submitted by the end of each financial quarter: March 31, June 30, September 30, December 31.
- 14. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.
- 15. Applications are submitted via the Pace Farm website.
- 16. Successful applications are reviewed by Pace Farm officials.
- 17. Grants are evaluated based on mission alignment, community impact, scope, and sustainability.
- 18. Grants are awarded at the discretion of the Pace Farm Community Grants Program team.
- 19. Funds are distributed within 10 working days after the recipient's acknowledgment.
- 20. Recipients must report on how the grant was used, including photos, for Pace Farm communications.
- 21. Feedback will not be provided to unsuccessful applicants.
